- Guide caregivers in building a care plan leading to their "Path of Least Regrets" in conjunction with their veterinary team
- Implement your plan and/or clients' plans while utilizing your knowledge when faced with new symptoms or situations
- Gain a better understanding of pain and suffering and how they relate to end of life decision making
- Learn about novel aftercare procedures, including remembrance and memorialization
- Help pet parents understand and experience both anticipatory and post-death grief as a process for healing and understanding their loss
- Gain skills that can help them to launch and grow their Animal Hospice business
- Provide care to others whose animals are in palliative and hospice care



Animal Hospice University

The Animal Hospice University (AHU) is a division of the Animal Hospice Group. AHU is unique as it offers Short Courses for practitioners of specific backgrounds, and will consist of chosen lectures that are of interest and specifically relevant to these varying backgrounds and areas of practice. What can I expect from the AHG Certification Program Levels?



Our full **Certified Animal Hospice Practitioner (CAHP) Certification Track** consists of **three levels** to expand your understanding about Animal Hospice and Palliative Care:

Level 1 is where you begin! At this level, you will learn the AHG Coursework and at completion, you will receive the certification of Certified Animal Hospice Foundations (CAHF). Level 1 is designed to be finished within 6 months in a flexible format allowing you, the student, to create a timeline that best fits your busy schedule. It consists of 9 Online Modules which are on-demand, streaming lectures with downloadable materials and quizzes to check understanding. Students can complete and the modules at their own pace within the course time period. Lecture quizzes guide students in identifying key points they will encounter on their final multiple choice exam.

Did we mention Discussion Groups? They are our students favorite part! They are scheduled several times each month, at multiple times and various days of the week, to maximize attendance by our international students and those with full time work schedules. These Groups provide opportunities for students to bring their questions to the AHG Founders, and allow participants to dig deeper into interesting topics and allow for questions, interactions, and networking with fellow students and graduates. Discussion Groups take place on Zoom and are recorded so all students may benefit from viewing the replays whether they are able to attend live or not. In addition, 8 hours minimum live attendance at Discussion Groups is required for Level 1 program completion.

Level 2 in the next step. Level 1 graduates may progress to Level 2 and deepen their impact through counseling and advancing from theory to practice. Level 2 Training empowers you to offer a shoulder to lean on and a hand to hold for pet parents navigating the emotional maze of terminal diagnoses and the grief of loss. This progression from theory to practice is a natural and essential step in professional development. After Level 2 completion, you will earn the certification of Certified Animal Hospice Counseling (CAHC).

Furthermore, **Level 3 is the last step**. Level 2 graduates may progress to Level 3, an Internship on the Animal Hospice Helpline under AHG Mentorship, which enables them to gain hands-on knowledge and experience in working with families and professionals like those they will encounter in their own practice as a Certified Animal Hospice Practitioner. Those completing Level 3 will fulfill 48 hours on the AHG Helpline and submit final assessments to demonstrate their competence and ability to work directly with animal caregivers and professionals whilst earning the certification of **Certified Animal Hospice Helpline Specialist (CAHHS)**.

After you have successfully completed Levels 1, 2, and 3, you will be awarded the distinction of **Certified Animal Hospice Practitioner (CAHP)**. Don't pass up this opportunity and join our network of CAHPs!
